QUALIFICATIONS:

PUPPY HUNT, POINT AND RETRIEVE: Dogs must be between 6 months (min) and 18 months (max) on the day of the test. Preference will be given to members in the draw.

NOVICE HUNT, POINT AND RETRIEVE: Confined to dogs that have not gained a place or Certificate of Merit at a Field Trial, been placed First, Second or Third in an Open Gundog Working Test or First in a Novice Gundog Working Test held in accordance with Kennel Club Rules and Field Trial Regulations. Preference will be given to members in the draw.

OPEN HUNT, POINT AND RETRIEVE: Preference will be given to dogs that have gained a place or Certificate of Merit at a Field Trial, been placed First, Second or Third in an Open Gundog Working Test or won a Novice Gundog Working Test held in accordance with Kennel Club Rules and Field Trial Regulations, should the Test be oversubscribed. Preference will be given to members in the draw.

UNCLASSIFIED: NOVICE DOG, NOVICE HANDLER: Confined to dogs and handlers that have not placed 1st-4th in novice working test. Preference will be given to members in the draw.

If running more than one dog in multiple tests, then both dogs must be taken with you throughout the day due to where cars are parked in relation to where the tests are.
